## UNC'S INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT LAUNCHES OUTREACH EDUCATION PROGRAM WITH LEADING IT SECURITY EXPERT

UNC partnering with IP3 to offer faculty, students and corporations scholarship dollars.
